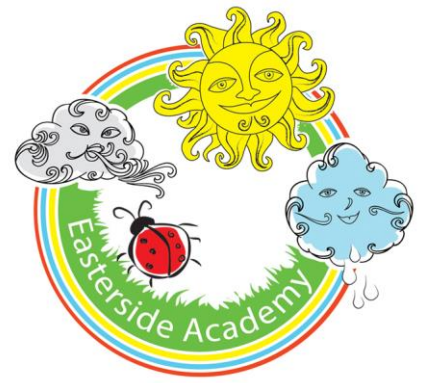


The Rainbow
