



Year 3/4 Potions

**Create a poem, rap or song about a potion and its effects on you or people around you.

**Write a recipe or instructions for making a potion. What would your potion be used for? If you would like, with the help of an adult, make your potion and bring it in to school to share with the class.

Design a bottle for your potion to go in. It could have a unique (original) shape or labelling. Try and make it as eye-catching as possible.

**Use a range of materials from home to create your own amazing model of a potion bottle. Can you write a short description to go with it?



Use Google to look up some potions and create an information poster or leaflet to show what you've found out. (Historical Enquiry)

Write a short story about either an adventure for Alice to go on when she leaves Wonderland, or you can be the main character? It could be based around the Easterside area? Imaginethe different potions / magic you could include in your narrative (story)? What characters would you meet? How could the story end?

Can you create a poster **advertising** a potion you have invented yourself? Remember to make the poster eye-catching so the public / target audience want to buy it. Just ask your teacher if you need any more advice.
